(3:30 – 4:15pm)

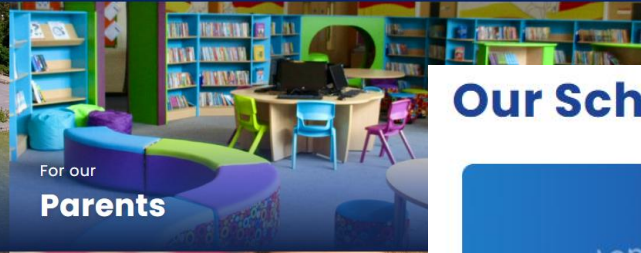
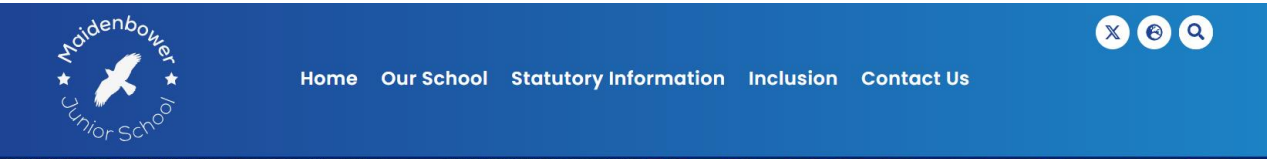
Tuesday 7th July – Year 2 children spend an hour with their new Y3 teacher at MJS pm

THE FIRST MORNING

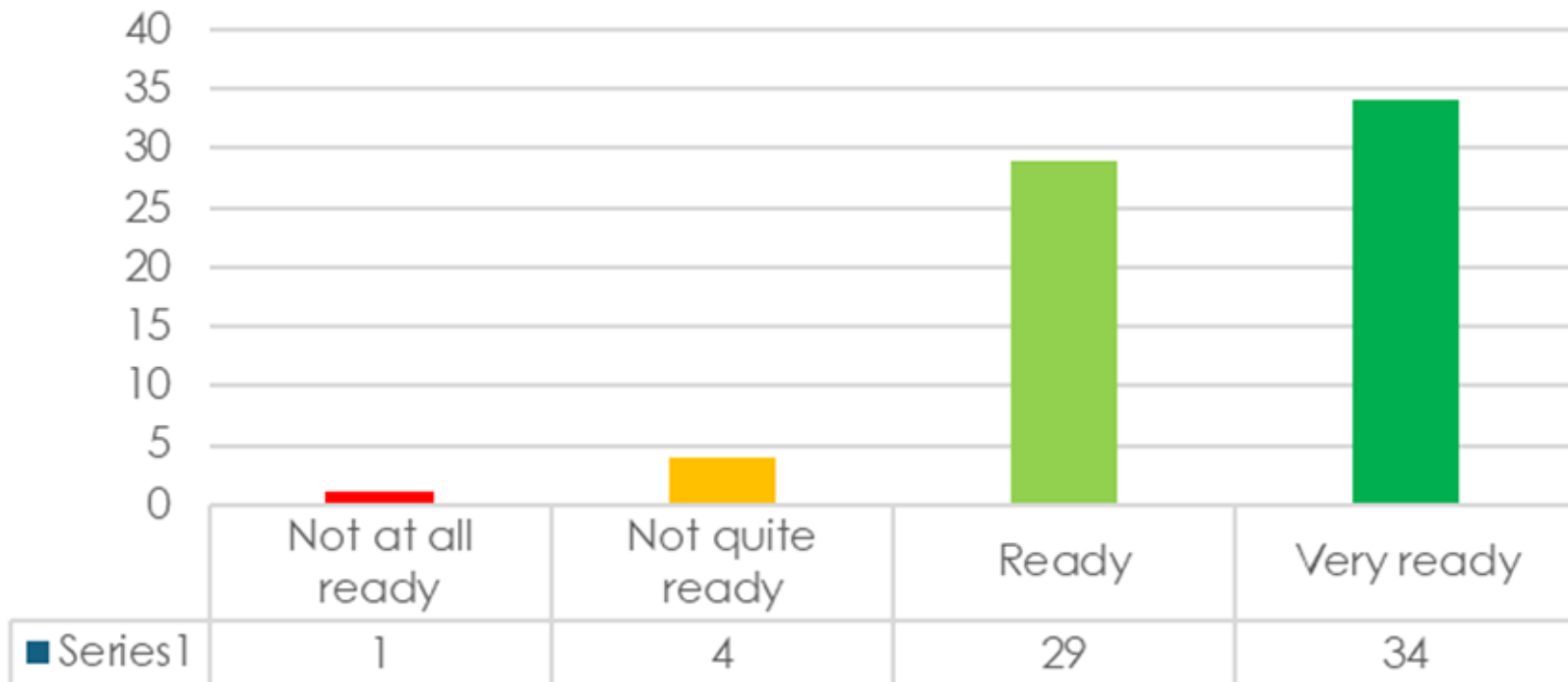
Thursday 3rd September 2026
