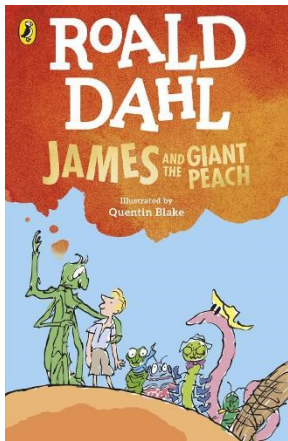


English
