Dear Parents/Carers

This week in school the children will be carrying on learning how use the column method for subtraction, both with and without regrouping. They will also be starting to look at fractions. Focussing, on unit and non-unit fractions.

In English, the children will be moving onto our main read: James and the Giant Peach. They will be using their comic book drawing skills to create their own diary as if they are James. Starting with life with his horrible aunts: Spiker and Sponge.

Reading: Read at least *four* times during the week. Please record these in the Reading Record (if your child has received theirs -some classes have not yet), which should have come home with your child today. Check the notes on the front of the Reading Record.

Spellings: Learn the words in this week's list. You do not need to hand in any evidence of your practice. We will be having a spelling test every Monday. The children should be able to access this week's spellings on EdShed (spelling shed) and play some fun games. The children's username is their usual one but with 'mjs' on the end of it. The password is their normal one. If your child(ren) is struggling with all the spelling, please prioritise the first four spellings, then the next four.
