Dear Parents/Carers

This week in school the children will be carrying on learning about fractions.

In English, after a week of immersing themselves into the world of Roald Dahl, we will be looking more deeply at the story of the Enormous Crocodile. The children will be listening to the story, acting it out and then writing their own version.

Reading: Read at least *four* times during the week. Please record these in the Reading Record (if your child has received theirs -some classes have not yet), which should have come home with your child today. Check the notes on the front of the Reading Record.

Spellings: Learn the words in this week's list. You do not need to hand in any evidence of your practice. We will be having a spelling test every Monday. The children should be able to access this week's spellings on EdShed (spelling shed) and play some fun games. The children's username is their usual one but with 'mjs' on the end of it. The password is their normal one. If your child(ren) is struggling with all the spelling, please prioritise the first four spellings, then the next four.
